Application for licensure/examination for veterinary technicians. the american association of veterinary state boards (aavsb) owns and administers the veterinary technician national exam (vtne). application for licensure/examination for veterinary technicians. type of application – all . applicants complete this section. F national exam scores: if you have previously taken and passed the veterinary technician national examination, your score needs to be sent to the department of health directly from aavsb. the passing score for the national examination is the criterion-referenced passing point scaled score established by the veterinary3. michigan requires that applicants for licensure by examination pass the veterinary technician national examination (vtne) in order to become licensed. 4. the licensure application and fee must be received in this office along with all supporting documents 45 days prior to the scheduled examination date to assure eligibility for the exam.
